Lary Coppola: By The Numbers

As Mayor, Lary Coppola managed to increase his salary from \$19,738 to a total of \$62,150 (plus benefits!) just months after running to serve as a part time mayor. That makes him among the highest in the region - nearly twice that of Bremerton's mayor on a per capita basis.

Just this past summer, Lary maneuvered to sell his commercial property to the City of Port Orchard for \$457,000, almost \$125,000 above its assessed value - the same property he claimed was over-assessed when he was threatening to sue the County over excessive valuation.
